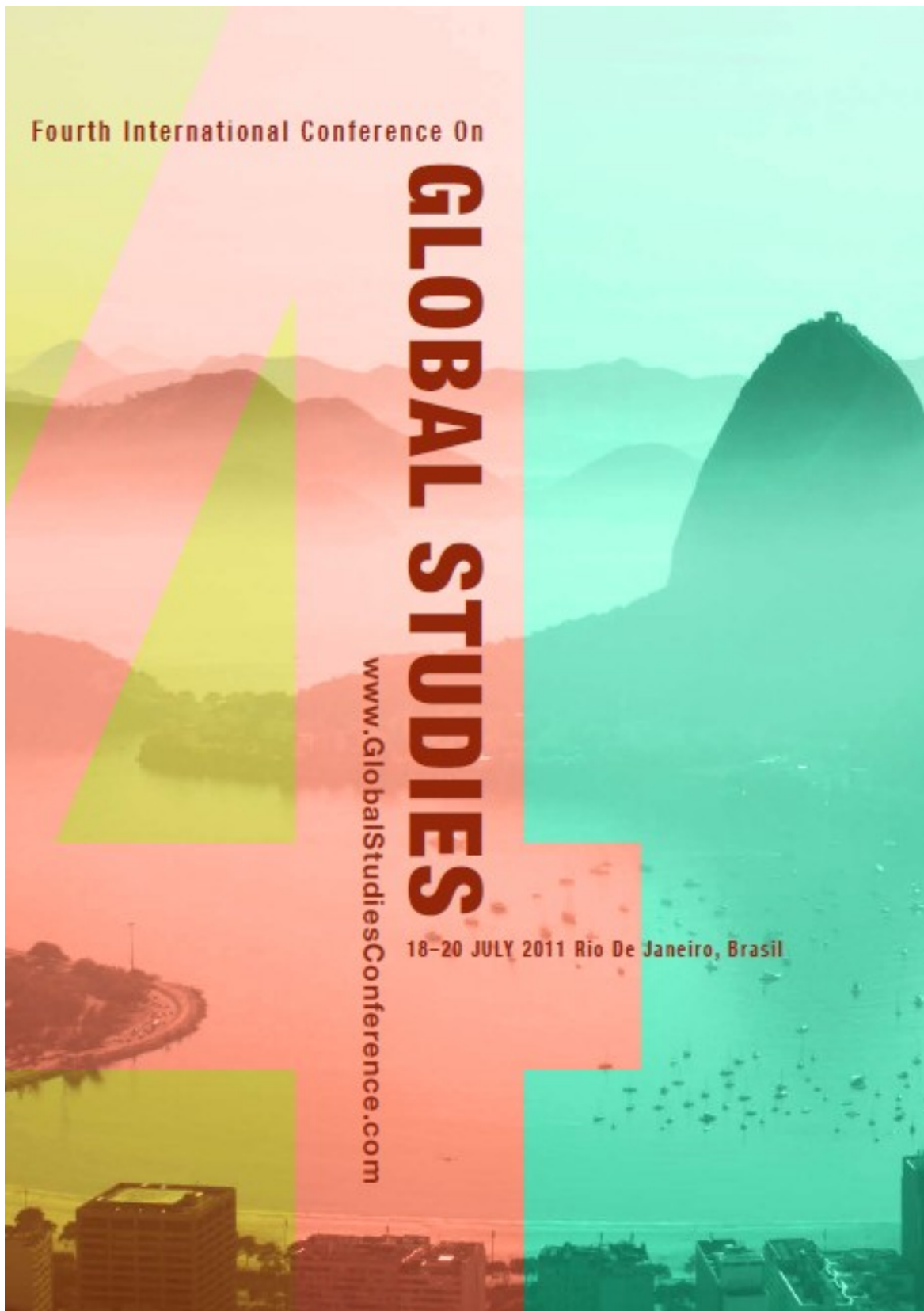

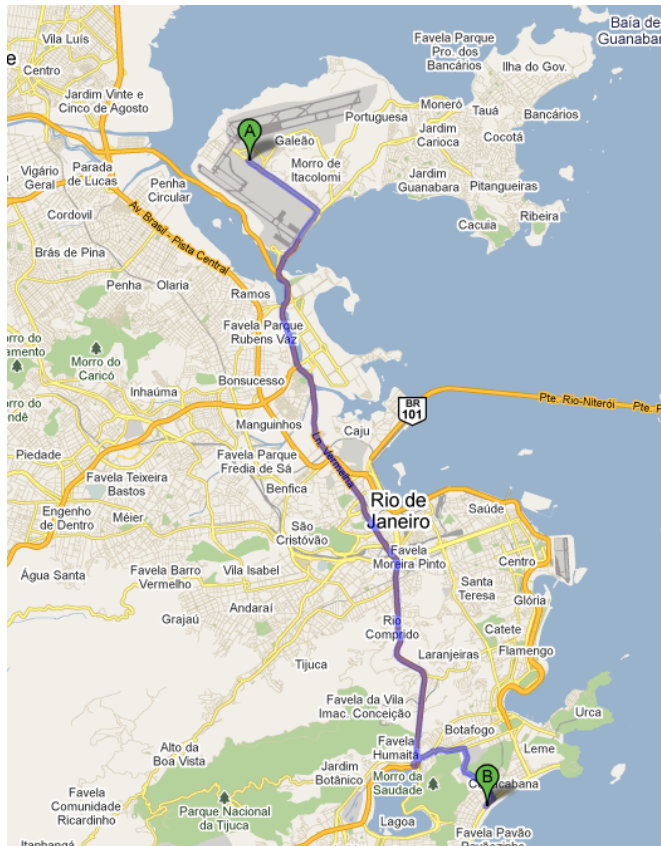
Transportation

Driving Directions –from Rio de Janeiro-Galeão International Airport (GIG) to JW Marriott

9.3 miles - Take Linha Vermelha and follow the signs to Centro/ Copacabana, Perimetral. Then take Aterro do Flamengo, Praia de Botafogo, cross Tunnel do Pasmado and Tunnel Novo. Take Avenida Princesa Isabel and turn right at Avenida Atlantica. Go straight to Posto Quatro.

JW Marriott Rio de Janeiro does not provide shuttle services.

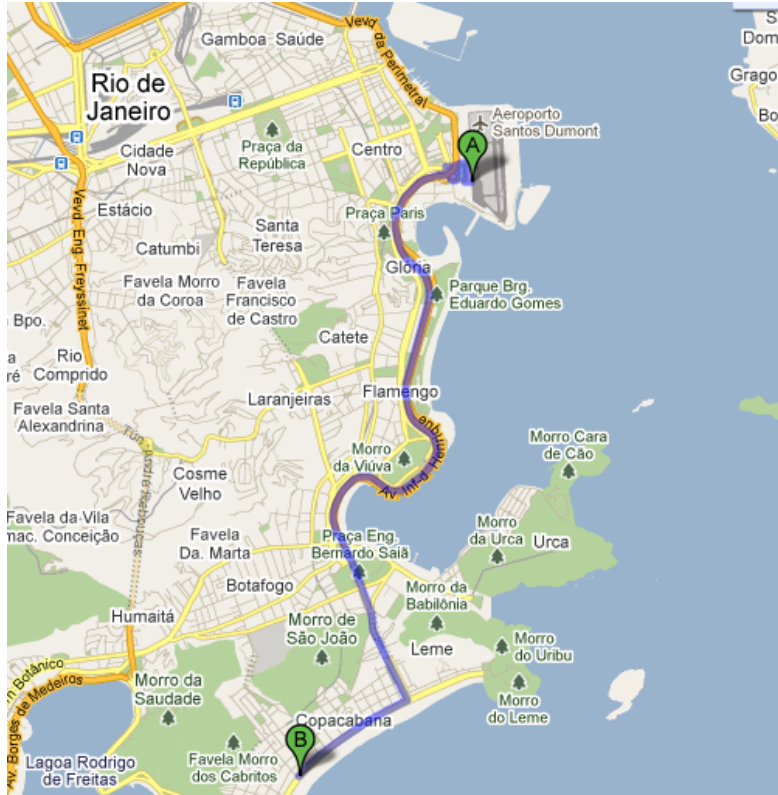
On-site parking fee & valet parking fee: 17 USD daily



Driving Directions – from Santos Dumont Airport (SDU) to JW Marriott

5.0 miles -Go down Avenida Atlantica, than take Avenida Princesa Isabel. Go straight to Aterro do Flamengo.

On-site parking fee & valet parking feel 17 USD daily



Taxi

All legal cabs are golden-yellow with a blue stripe painted on the sides. You can ask most cabs for a city tour and arrange a fixed price (probably around 20.00 USD). Major taxi companies include Central de Taxi, Ouri Taxi, and Yellow Taxi

Estimated taxi fare: 55.00 USD (one way) from Rio de Janeiro-Galeão International Airport (GIG) to JW Marriott

Estimated taxi fare: 35.00 USD (one way) from Santos Dumont Airport (SDU) to JW Marriott.

Bus

Local buses are known as the Frescao. There are over 1000 bus lines in Rio de Janeiro but here are no schedules or timetables. There is a helpful book called Ruas de Rio de Janeiro (The streets of Rio de Janeiro) that contains maps and lists bus routes by bus line. Usually buses run every 15 minutes but less during the nighttime hours. Bus tickets usually start around ~1.50 USD. There is no change given so it is advantageous to carry small bills/coins. It is advised to stay aware for pickpockets.

The long distance bus service is the Rodoviária Novo Rio. More information can be found on their website found [here](#).

Subway

The Metrô Rio subway system is very useful for reaching areas from Copacabana to Downtown. It is the safest transport in Rio. The air-conditioned subway is clean, comfortable, and quick, and in 2006 it includes bilingual Portuguese-English signs, maps, and a loudspeaker system to make the life of foreign tourists. There are two main lines: Line 1 (Orange) has service to Copacabana, the Saara district, and much of Downtown, as well as Tijuca, where you can visit Corcovado. Line 2 (Green) stops at the zoo, Maracanã stadium, and Rio State University. The two lines intersect at Estácio station. Operating hours are 5 am to midnight Monday through Saturday and 7 am to 11 pm on Sundays and Holidays.

The Copacabana – Siqueira Campos Station is 1.2 miles from the JW Marriott Hotel Rio De Janeiro.

A single ticket is ~2.00 USD.

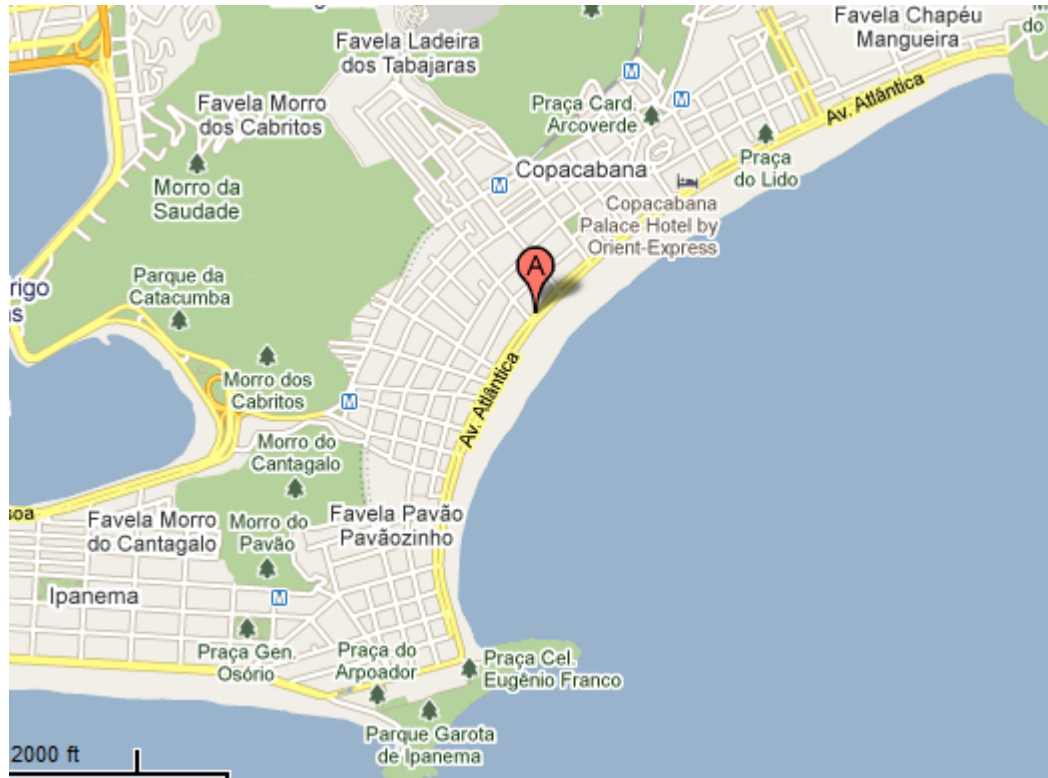
